Head Coach - With the help of Attleboro Fastpitch Coach Training and Manuals, head coaches will teach softball skills, manage games, conduct practices and coordinate team volunteers. Ensures that team is prepared for games. Commitment requires a minimum of 4-6 hours a week.\*\*

Assistant Coach: Takes directions from and assists the head coach in his/her responsibilities. May direct specific drills at practices and/or be responsible for the line-up during games. Commitment requires 4-6 hours a week.\*\*

Team Parent: Assists coaches in handling administrative matters for the team. Responsibilities may include telephone calls to players/parents and/or the distribution of information to the team regarding Softball matters. Team parent may also help on the bench with equipment organization.

Field Assistance: Take direction from the Field Manager. Prepare fields for game play which includes dragging, raking and lining. Training provided.

Spring All-Star Travel Teams – Competitive softball with practices in March and April. Double-header games with surrounding towns on Sunday mornings in April and May with a weekend-long tournament in early June! Experienced coaching and indoor cage time included. \$110 per player

Summer All-Star Travel Teams – Competitive softball with practices in June. Weeknight games against towns in the Hockomock Girls Summer Softball League (HGSSL) through June and July with a chance to make playoffs and win a championship! Girls will play in at least two weekend tournaments! Experienced coaching and indoor cage time included. \$180 per player

Fall Ball Travel Team – Fall Ball is played with other participating towns with most players moving up to their new age groups where applicable. Sunday morning games are a great introduction to players and parents to a multi-town competitive league. \$110 per player
